San Francisco-based Village Green Energy was founded in 2007 by Robby Bearman, Mike Jackson, and Jesse Krieger. Since its inception, Village Green has grown to seven employees.

Village Green Energy enables households and businesses to purchase renewable energy from wind farms, solar arrays, and other renewable generators through the electricity grid. We do this through the sale of Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs), the legal environmental rights to renewable power. When customers purchase these rights, they force electric utilities to generate additional renewable power.

Village Green focuses on providing renewable power to green buildings and real estate - including building projects seeking LEED certification - and to the food and entertainment industry with their trademark Sustainability Contribution service. Most recently, Village Green has been working with California wineries to push for more sustainable practices in the wine industry.
